

From the pier you will be taken to Pakbeng Hill Town to explore the including the local market, where all local people of Pakbeng district come to do their daily shopping, here you will see a variety of local foods and products including dried buffalo skin, local tea and saltpeter among the chickens, fish, vegetables and fruit, everything needed for daily life in Laos.

Feel free to have some snacks or lunch in Pakbeng Town, there are plenty of places to eat. Recommend fresh coffee and morning baked muffin whilst sitting looking above the Mighty Mekong River.

After your short rest, you will continue to look at the two Temples. Which are rustic and colorful with amazing views. From the Temples is a nice steady walk back to the resort, to relax and swim.

The 6 km plus trek is easy-medium trek, in the park a little steep in parts. For Pakbeng you will be walking along the roadsides
